9. FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS (TAB 2)

ESL would like to recommend lifting the one-year suspension of enrollment of foreign exchange students for the 2021-2022 school year as challenges with COVID continue to improve.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve lifting the one-year suspension of foreign exchange students being enrolled into Rutherford County Schools for the 2021-2022 school year.

10. CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION (TAB 3)

1. <u>Learning Management System</u>: After receiving feedback from educators regarding our current LMS, and after consultation from our Learning Management System Review Committee, the Instruction Department is requesting to purchase Schoology (Operated by PowerSchool) to serve as the learning management system for the 21-22 school year at a cost of \$208,520. While we do not like transitioning platforms after one year, a different platform is being requested to meet the needs of students and teachers in RCS. Funding for this purchase is pending approval of funds for ESSER 2.0. Once funding is received, training and implementation will begin immediately in preparation for the 21-22 school year.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve the purchase of Schoology for the 21-22 school year at a cost of \$208,520 pending ESSER 2.0 funding approval.

2. <u>Zoom Video Communications</u>: The Instruction Department is requesting to renew The purchase of Zoom Video Communications for use for the 21-22 school year.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve the purchase of Zoom Video Communications for the 21-22 school year.

3. Rutherford County Virtual School Co-Op Agreement:

Rutherford County Schools Virtual School seeks permission to add athletics to students beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. This will allow RCS Virtual School to offer its students many of the athletic opportunities afforded to students at our other RCS schools. It is confirmed with TSSAA that a Virtual School is eligible for membership.

Further, RCS Virtual School Seeks permission to enter into an athletics co-op agreement with Central Magnet School in the following sports: Baseball, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, Softball, Volleyball, Golf, Cross Country, Track, Cheerleading, Dance, Archery, Swimming. TSSAA confirms that our Virtual School can co-op with another TSSAA school, with RCS Board approval.

Central Magnet has a long-standing co-op agreement with Eagleville in Tennis, Boys Soccer, Girls Soccer, Bowling, and Wrestling, and therefore cannot co-op with RCS Virtual School in these sports. RCS Virtual School will offer these sports if/when They can be supported by school student participation. When that occurs, facility availability will need to be considered.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve RCVS cooperative partnership with Central Magnet for sports as presented.

4. Rutherford County Virtual School:

Rutherford County Virtual School plans to expand to offer grades 3-12 for the 21-22 school year. As part of the expansion, Rutherford County Schools will utilize our own teachers for at least grades 3-8. To begin this process, Curriculum and Instruction is requesting to use ESSER 2.0 funding to add ten certified detaching positions, one instructional coach position, and one school counselor position. The funding for these positions are pending ESSER 2.0 approval from TDOE.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve funding of additional staffing positions for Rutherford County Virtual School for the 21-22 school year.

11. FACILITIES (TAB 4)

Five Year School Building Program:

The Proposed 5 Year Building Program is presented for approval along with the request for the 2021-2022 Annex for Rockvale Elementary, 20 classroom addition for Rockvale Middle and an interior renovation for Smyrna Middle School. The Rockvale Elementary Annex project will be the same construction as Rock Springs Elementary. This year's request is \$31,395,000.00 with subsequent reviews each year.

Recommended Approval---motion to approve the 5 Year Building Program and the requested projects for the 2021-2022 school year as presented.

New Road for the Plainview School Complex:

The Plainview Committee met on Tuesday March 9, 2021 for the purpose of naming the roadway from Sledge Road to Hoovers Gap. A portion of the road will become a county roadway. The committee recommends the new road name to be Otter Pond Way. If this has been taken, we will submit Otter Way as a second recommendation. Once approved, Engineering and Construction will submit the name for approval to 911 to establish the physical addresses for Plainview Elementary.

12. FINANCIAL MATTERS

Formation of a Study Committee to Review Employee Health Insurance Options

In response to the request of numerous school employees for the School Board to review options for employee's health insurance offerings in light of insurance premium increases, a study committee is to be created. This committee will be made up of a school board member, a REA representative, a certified classroom teacher, a school administrator, the Assistant Superintendent of Budget and Finance, the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources and

two classified support staff members. This committee will review the following and make a formal recommendation to the Board of Education:

- 1. Review the current county employee health insurance plan rates, coverage, deductibles and physician networks. The committee will meet with county health plan representatives to review these items and have any questions answered about these plans.
- 2. Review the State of Tennessee health insurance plan rates, coverage deductibles and physician networks available to LEA's. The committee will meet with State of Tennessee Health Plan Representatives to review these items and have any questions answered about these plans.
- 3. The committee will then report its study findings to the Board of Education with any recommendations after this in-depth study is completed.

The Director stated this is a fact-finding mission to attain input from our staff. Dr. Anthony gave a breakdown of dates which will be used to attain input. March 9th will be a discussion of the scope and background. March 11th will be designated for The State Insurance Representatives to speak. March 16th will be for Rutherford County Insurance Representatives and March 25 will be a wrap up meeting to discuss items and any additional information.
